Hanni Fakhoury is a Senior Staff Attorney on the Electronic Frontier Foundation's civil liberties team, focusing on criminal law. He's represented clients in criminal and civil government investigations, has argued the constitutionality of surveillance technologies in federal court, and written numerous amicus briefs in federal and state courts throughout the country on electronic searches and cybercrime. Hanni is a frequent speaker and lecturer at domestic and international legal conferences on law enforcement surveillance technologies, and is regularly interviewed and quoted by news media organizations. Before joining EFF, Hanni was a federal public defender in San Diego where he handled all aspects of criminal litigation including trial and appeal. He still represents indigent federal criminal defendants on direct appeal and prisoners in post-conviction proceedings as a member of the Northern District of California's Criminal Justice Act appellate panel. Hanni graduated from the University of California, Berkeley with a degree in political science and an honors degree in history, and received his law degree with distinction from Pacific McGeorge School of Law, where he was elected to the Order of Barristers for his excellence in written and oral advocacy.
