

Jeffrey Mausner former outside counsel for Perfect 10

Jeffrey Mausner was an attorney specializing in copyright and intellectual property law. He represented Perfect 10 Magazine in landmark cases against Google, Microsoft, Amazon.com, and Cybernet Ventures for copyright infringement and violation of rights of publicity on the Internet. He was selected as a "Southern California Super Lawyer" for the past seven years by Los Angeles Magazine. He was also an Adjunct Professor at Southwestern University Law School, where he taught Advanced Copyright, Internet and Computer Law, and Intellectual Property Law. In 2001, he received Southwestern's Adjunct Excellence in Teaching Award. From 2003 to 2004, Jeff was President of the Los Angeles Copyright Society.

Jeff formerly worked as a federal prosecutor for the United States Justice Department, where he received numerous awards from the Attorney General for his work in prosecuting Nazi war criminals. He received the U.S. Justice Department Meritorious Award for "Superior Performance of Duties on a Continuous Basis," the Exceptional Performance Award, and the Justice Department Special Achievement Award, among others. Jeff graduated magna cum laude from Cornell Law School, where he was an editor of the Law Review. Jeff retired from practicing law in 2012.
