Peter S. Menell is Robert L. Bridges Professor of Law at the University of California at Berkeley School of Law (Boalt Hall). For the 2011-12 academic year, he is Herman Phleger Visiting Professor of Law at Stanford Law School. He co-founded and serves as a Director of the Berkeley Center for Law and Technology. He earned his S.B. from the MIT, Ph.D. (economics) from Stanford University, and J.D. from Harvard Law School. Professor Menell joined the law faculty at the University of California at Berkeley in 1990, where much of his research and teaching have focused on intellectual property. He has also organized numerous intellectual property education programs for the Federal Judicial Center and co-authored the Patent Case Management Judicial Guide.
