The purpose of this form is to certify the applicant's completion of the pro bono requirement.

Pro Bono Hours (Public Service): Students must complete 50 hours of on-campus or community volunteer work promoting public interest and social justice, as defined by the Pro Bono Recognition Program. The hours cannot be paid or for unit credit. The work may be law-related, but need not be. Work as an officer or active member of a campus student organization does not count toward fulfillment of this requirement. The same pro bono hours may be used towards both the annual Pro Bono Recognition awards and the graduation certificate.
