

# Charney 101 Classroom

This room in Charney Hall has been designed as a collaborative space with movable changes and tables so that you can configure the room as you see fit. The eight LED screens in the room allow for collaboration between teams using Apple TVs found in the room.

## Technology in the classroom:

- Desktop PC and Mac
- Wacom Screen
- Laptop Connection (VGA, HDMI)
- Blu-Ray Player
- Assistive Listening
- Apple TV
- 4 microphones (2 lapel and 2 handhelds) which are available for checkout
- Podium Microphone
- Classroom Capture
- Video Conferencing using Zoom or Skype
- Ethernet Connection
- Whiteboard
- Projection System
- Audio System
- Movable Tables and Chairs
- Eight LED Screens

## How do I operate the equipment?



## Presentation Mode

You can determine whether you want the source selected to project on the projectors only or on all the screens in the room. Control is then the same as the other classrooms.

## Collaboration Mode

This will allow you to select separate sources to collaborate in the space. By default, each Apple TV is routed to each LED screen in the room. You would use an Apple Laptop with airplay to connect to each screen. Control is then the same as the other classrooms.

To power on the system, press the power button at the home screen. This will power on the system and lower the projection screen.

**PC/Mac**

This will select the desktop you'd like to use in the classroom

**Blu-ray**

You are able to play Bluray or DVD discs. The Bluray Control screen will provide you with control for common functions such as play, rewind, fast-forward, and stop.

**Apple TV**

All our classrooms are equipped with Apple TV. Look for the room on your Apple Device then input the password on the projector screen to connect.

**Laptop**

VGA and HDMI connections are provided at the instructors podium. The system will automatically select HDMI or VGA based on the cable connected.

**Audio Control**

Control volume levels in the room.

**Camera Control**

This is used to control and adjust the camera for both classroom capture and video conferencing. The camera selected is what is used for capture. You can select between two cameras.

**Volume**

Volume control for the entire classroom.

**Projector Mute**

This will blank out the projector. Tap to toggle on/off.

**Projector On/Off**

This will turn the projector on and off.

**Audio/Camera/Bluray/Apple TV Control**

This will show you the control options for each source.

Please remember to shut off the system after you are done using the room. This is done by tapping **System Off**. When prompted, please tap **Yes**.
