GET BOOSTED!

All vaccinated students are required to be boosted as soon as eligible.



UPLOAD UPDATED PROOF OF VACCINATION!

Once you receive your booster, upload your updated proof of vaccination to the Cowell Health Center website by March 17, 2022.



MASK UP!

Remember to always wear a mask while indoors. Your mask should cover your mouth and nose. The university recommends using a 95, KN 95, and KF 94 if possible.



COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR PROFESSORS!

Some Professors have decided to conduct the first week of classes remotely. If your classes are in-person, you may have the option to participate remotely for the first 2 weeks. Be sure to communicate with your Professors early!



GET TESTED!

All law students are required to get tested 2x during the first week they physically return to campus. Testing **MUST** occur through the University testing system. Testing is self-administered. The nearest testing sites to Charney Hall are located in the Vari Hall lobby, the Lucas Hall lobby, and Benson Center.

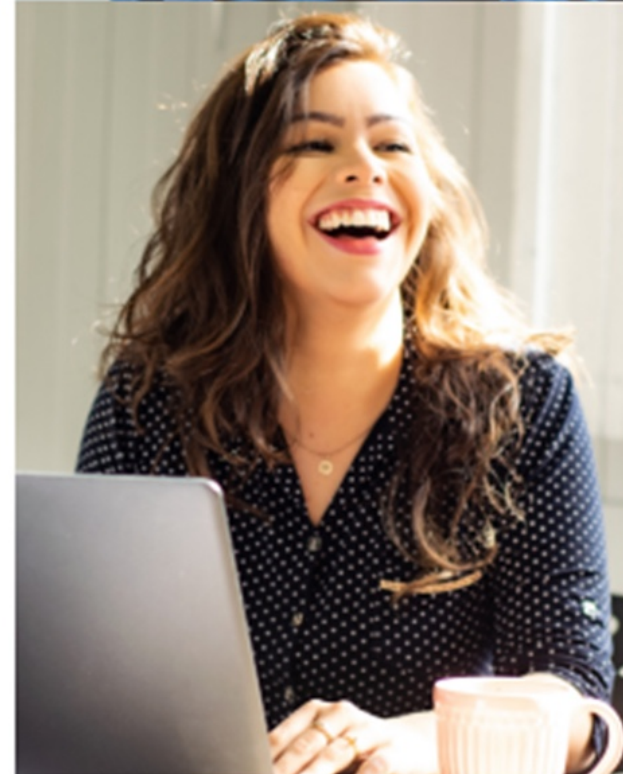

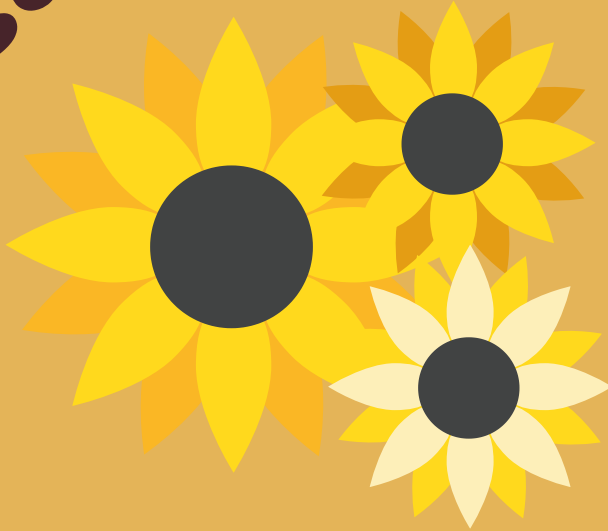
